POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Associate Pastor, supported by and reporting to the Lead Pastor, leads the church in equipping worshipping disciples who make disciples that share the life-changing love of Jesus with their neighbors.

The primary goal of this position is to achieve: life-giving and growing discipleship pathways for all age groups; inspirational worship environments that lead to God encounters; a culture of spiritually growing relationships that result in intentional and frequent next-steps in faith formation.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Disciple.** Intentionally guide and pastor people through the discipleship pathway helping them to experience Jesus dependent lives, Spiritually Growing Relationships, Grace Filled Community, and Neighbor Serving Disciples.
