The Power of We: Abudant Living in Acts

A C T S

The book of Acts covers the birth of church and ministry of the Apostles following Jesus' ascension through Paul's missionary journeys. It was written by Luke as the second part of Luke's gospel as witness to the Good News to a gentile named Theopholus. The focus on the transforming power of the Holy Spirit as the good news of Jesus spreads from Jerusalem, to Judea, Samaria, and eventually the whole world. The book is divided into two main sections, the first being the formation of the first church in Jerusalem under Peter's leadership and the mandate to reach the Gentiles. The second part follows Paul after his conversion on his missionary journey's as new communities of Christ followers begin in cities and towns around the Mediterranean. *The power of the Holy Spirit transforms these early friends and witnesses of Jesus into abundant gospel communities on mission.*

THE EMPOWERED KINGDOM EXPANDS

Luke emphasizes that the miraculous ministry of Jesus has now passed onto all believers through the ministry of the Holy Spirit. Luke is careful to emphasize the transforming effect of individual believers and communites as they band together to witness to Jesus the Messiah and minister in the power of His transforming love. Despite challenges and persecution the abudant Christian community expands the Kingdom of God to the whole world.


